- 4. A child under the age of twenty-one should submit either under legal first name plus initial of family name or under a fake name of his or her own choosing.
- 5. The first twelve complete and valid lists submitted in each category will be posted at the LVCA website (lvcinemaassociation.com).

- 7. Each title should be followed by the year of its release according to Internet Movie Data Base (IMDB) information.
- 8. Adults may assist children in compiling and typing their lists.

- 11. All approved lists will be posted at the LVCA website no later than December 23, 2023.
